One of the team goals was to develop pupil voice across the schools. An example of the work done so far has been asking all children their thoughts and feelings around play times and lunchtimes. The Pupil Parliament then looked at the data that they had collected and developed a plan on how to address some of the issues. As a result of the findings, the group then ordered a range of books that they believe will teach children how to improve attitudes, develop resilience and empower pupils.

In addition, our Pupil Parliament has made two presentations to the Board of Trustees who commented on their excellent public speaking skills.

Spotlight On... Paul Belcher

I have worked at Curwen since 2011, initially as PE Subject Leader, before joining The Tapscott Learning Trust in September as the Competition & Sports Development Lead. So what do I do?

When I am not teaching, I manage a school sports competition calendar for the TTLT Schools and this includes inviting other schools in the borough to enter. Each year group will have at least one competition per term ranging from Mini Olympics to Rugby and Football Festivals, Girls Active Events and, hopefully, a Swimming Gala in July.

Points are awarded on a sliding scale. E.g. If five schools enter a competition, the winning school receives 5 points, 2nd 4 points, 3rd 3 points and so on. If 10 schools enter a competition the winning school receives 10 points, 2nd 9 points and so on. In some competitions points are awarded for participation only.



Updates from the Training Hub:

The Training Hub continues to provide opportunities for our staff across the Trust to develop professionally. This term has seen the continuation of our TTLT leadership programme in partnership with the Institute of Education, as well as work in supporting and developing new leaders across our schools. We have continued to develop other training programmes ranging from Autism, Reading and one - one teacher support. To date, the Training Hub has provided over 500 staff training sessions. And we are also extremely pleased to announce a new partnership with Street Games, a sports charity helping disadvantaged communities, which will see us recruit and develop Sport Coach Apprentices in our schools. This is a fantastic opportunity, not only for young people in our community, but also for our Trust in developing skilled members of our P.E teams that will benefit our children.
