- Year 1 to July 2022

 delivery and training. Through this it improves the outcomes and activity levels of all children in the Trust and beyond,

- Governance development and support has been developed and is sustainable to provide services internally but also
 externally to other settings ensuring compliance, quality and effective oversight to improve outcomes for all children
- Provision of operational and financial services internally or outsourced ensure reduced bureaucracy and maximum focus on provision for children
- All children have access to top quality digital resources set against our expectations
- Effective systems and structures means the numbers of pupils educated or supported by the Trust has risen to 4000
