The news has been full of content recently concerning PSHE/ RSHE. The Government are conducting a review into RSHE, three years on from the 2019 statutory guidance being implemented.

Schools PSHE/RSHE policy will need to be revised and updated in the next academic year, including parental consutlation. The Newham PSHE Partnership has the experience, expertise and ability to train and advise staff and keep the SLT up to date with the changes they need to implement.

Internal & external compliancy reviews of RSHE

The Newham PSHE Partnership (previously the RSHE Partnership) has spent the last three years preparing schools to effectively deliver RSHE as stipulated by the DfE Statutory Guidance (2019). Most schools are doing an amazing job at teaching this new curriculum, but may still feel that they want to ensure that their policy, curriculum content, parent engagement and the confidence and ability of staff to teach RSHE are compliant with the guidance. To support schools in this The Partnership are able to supply schools with three levels of review. Documents have been devised, by way of:

- 1. A questionnaire for pupils
- 2. A questionnaire for the RSHE Lead

3. A compliance matrix (which outlines curriculum that should be taught and how teaching should be carried out)

There are three levels of review that can be carried out in schools.

1. Basic Internal review

Providing documents for a school to carry out their own compliance review.

These will be licensed to individual schools and should not be shared, even with in MATS.

Cost: £150

2. Supported internal review

Documents provided and then worked through with an Advisor to ensure compliance with the statutory and additional guidance. Support and advice given where needed.

Cost: £350 for half day £650 whole day

Any additional time needed will be charged at £250 a half day

3. Independent external review

This will include the above, but also a website, policy and curriculum review, pupil consultations, book look and staff discussion. A written report can also be commissioned.

Cost: Bespoke prices arranged depending on the size of the school and the amount of support needed

Parents and carers from all year groups were invited to attend (in the toolkit, the letter sent out to parents and carers has been shared). The workshops were very popular and the parents and carers who attended appreciated the opportunity to hear about the importance of PSHE and RSHE from other parents' perspectives. The workshops facilitated the opportunity for participants to discuss any concerns or fears they may have had around PSHE or RSHE and how it is taught in school. This meant that opportunities for good communication between school and parents in this area could be established, promoted and/or consolidated. We think that the workshops would be great to use during policy consultations and with new parents and carers at the start of each new academic year."

Borough-wide consultation findings

During 2023-2024 Newham PSHE partnership undertook an extensive borough wide consultation around RSHE.

Partnership schools will gain our summary findings, as well as access to more detailed findings from all the different groups we have consulted with. Importantly we have just completed our analysis on what over 2500 pupils have told us about what is important to them, what they are worried about and what is going well. Essential reading for all schools.

New for 2024-2025 will be our school advice on how to lead successful consultation with partners at your school. PLUS a document you can share with parents/carers around what is consultation - it will set out what can not be changed and where schools are seeking parent/carers ideas, thoughts and suggestions.

Newham for 2024-2025 will be our revised model RSHE policy documents for primary and secondary schools.

Finally we will run some webinars for SLT and PSHE leads to ensure you are clear on our advice, as well as have the opportunity to ask any questions you want to ask.
