As the Newham PSHE partnership, we have been able to support each other in our need to comply with the new statutory guidance for RSHE (DfE,2019) but whilst the work will continue in making sure that statutory RSHE is taught well in Newham's schools, it is also important for our pupils to gain knowledge and skills concerning other issues such as economic well-being and citizenship.

By signing up to The Newham PSHE Partnership, you will get more for your money this year as we have kept our prices low even though costs have gone up.

The news has been full of content recently concerning PSHE/RSHE. The Government are conducting a review into RSHE, three years on from the 2019 statutory guidance being implemented.

Schools PSHE/RSHE policy will need to be revised and updated in the next academic year, including parental consutlation. The Newham PSHE Partnership has the experience, expertise and ability to train and advise staff and keep the SLT up to date with the changes they need to implement.

Ensure that your school is abreast of any developments, staff are trained and informed and that PSHE is of high quality. Ensure that Personal Development in your schools is Ofsted ready and your PSHE is sensitive, effective and robust, equipping your pupils for life in 21st century Britain, by joining the Newham PSHE Partnership for 2023-24.

Prices on page 12 are for schools with 500+ pupils; for schools with below 500 pupils a bespoke price will be calculated for your school, based on your pupil numbers.

PSHE Association Membership

Through purchasing this together as a borough we can lower the price for each school, by the special deal we have negotiated saving each school £55.

As a member of the Newham RSHE Partnership you will have free membership of the PSHE association, which provides curriculum plans, resources for schools governors and parents, and which informs the policy and practise of the DFE in this field. Internal & external compliancy reviews of RSHE

The Newham PSHE Partnership (previously the RSHE Partnership) has spent the last three years preparing schools to effectively deliver RSHE as stipulated by the DfE Statutory Guidance (2019). Most schools are doing an amazing job at teaching this new curriculum, but may still feel that they want to ensure that their policy, curriculum content, parent engagement and the confidence and ability of staff to teach RSHE are compliant with the guidance. To support schools in this The Partnership are able to supply schools with three levels of review. Documents have been devised, by way of:

- 1. A questionnaire for pupils
- 2. A questionnaire for the RSHE Lead
- 3. A compliance matrix (which outlines curriculum are as that should be taught and how teaching should be carried out)

There are three levels of review that can be carried out in schools.

1. Basic Internal review

Providing documents for a school to carry out their own compliance review.

These will be licensed to individual schools and should not be shared, even with in MATS.

Cost: £150

2. Supported internal review

Documents provided and then worked through with an Advisor to ensure compliance with the statutory and additional guidance. Support and advice given where needed.

Cost: £350 for half day £650 whole day

Any additional time needed will be charged at £250 a half day

3. Independent external review

This will include the above, but also a website, policy and curriculum review, pupil consultations, book look and staff discussion. A written report can also be commissioned.

Cost: Bespoke prices arranged depending on the size of the school and the amount of support needed

Any Questions sessions

These sessions held on zoom are for any school in partnership to be able and come and discuss questions, situations arising in their school with our PSHE/RSHE advisors. It operates a bit like a doctors surgery.
