Teaching has always been a passion of mine and brings me so much joy; every day is different and I feel that I learn from my students as much as I teach them - if not more! It is extremely satisfying to see children progress academically and socially and to be a part of their development as they become rounded individuals and future citizens.

I have been a teacher at Kensington Primary school for half a decade and hold a special place in my heart for this school because of its dynamic and holistic approach to learning. Kensington's approach is very similar to the Early Years curriculum in undertaking a child-centred view. Our approach does not solely focus on academics, but also looks at the child as a whole.

Kensington has a friendly environment that has welcomed me with open arms, which in turn has allowed me to make mistakes and grow. The school has huge enthusiasm for staff well-being, with a positive ethos, making me feel valued and appreciated; this approach has motivated me to push myself further across the school to participate and lead in additional ventures.

At the moment, I am part of the well-being team, encouraging and promoting staff-wellbeing. I organise laid back lunch where we encourage people to bring in food to share, thus encouraging an environment for cross year group bonding. I also have the responsibility of ordering healthy breakfast items for staff to ensure they are fed and ready to have a great day.

Recently I have been put in charge of overseeing the EYFS playground, ensuring that it meets the needs of our neuro-diverse children and supports the children with learning through play. I have also had the privilege of visiting numerous schools to observe good practice and to feed back to SLT what I believe the children need to thrive in a safe and educated environment.

These opportunities have further developed my experience and skillset, enabling me to take on more leadership roles. This year I am undergoing an Early Years Lead course (NPQEL) with the intention to be an Early Years lead in the future. I know that the skills that I have learnt and developed at Kensington and through TTLT's CPD sessions will stay with me forever and continue to inform and shape my practice.
