Content Coverage

Session 1:

What does it mean to be a successful cover supervisor?

Exploring themes covered:

- What is the expectation of a cover supervisor?
- How do we best prepare to cover lessons?
- What is important to consider and what potential problems can we face?
- Identifying own areas of development and how we approach developing these
- Basic CPD and overview of ICT applications including ActiveInspire and Google
- Take away and try task

Session 2:

How do we manage behaviour and the challenges we face?

Exploring themes covered:

- Why is positive behaviour important for learning?
- Experience discussion exploring challenges such as age, curriculum, SEND and other adults
- Behaviour strategies - school, class and own systems
- Behaviour scenarios and what we do
- Sharing strategies to us
- Take away and try task

Session 3:

How do we support and deliver the curriculum to the best of our ability?

Exploring themes covered:

- using a range of questions to self reflect and unpick challenges faced in delivering lessons
