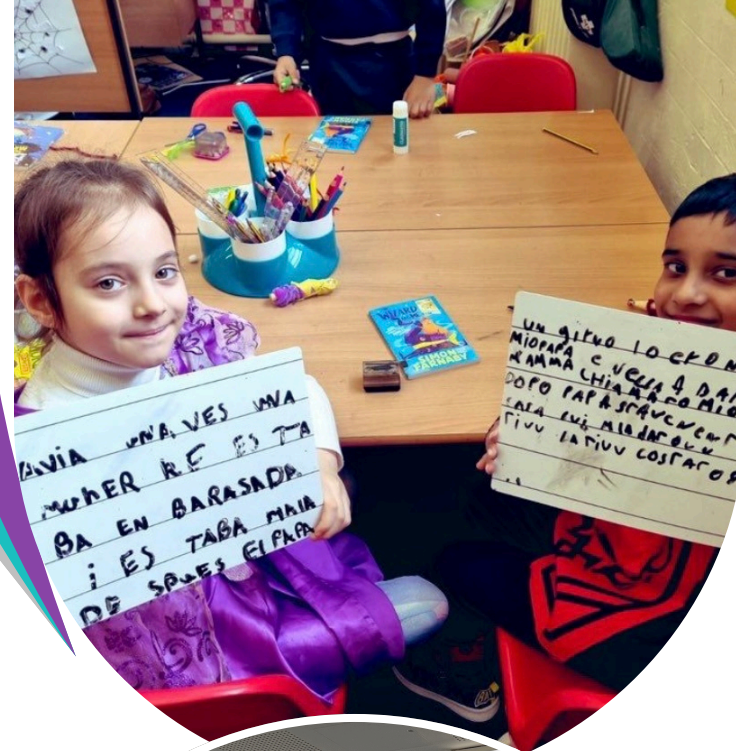

Two Tiered Package Training

We realise not all schools are at the same point in their journey with Multilingualism. TTLT have created two separate training options for schools and trusts to consider. Tier 1 focuses on core systems, shared language and practical strategies and is designed for schools who want to move from good intentions to consistent, equitable practice for multilingual learners. The additional Training in Tier 2 supports key staff and teams (EYFS, SEND, pastoral and senior leaders) to make accurate judgments, provide support and respond confidently to inspection, safeguarding and inclusion challenges.

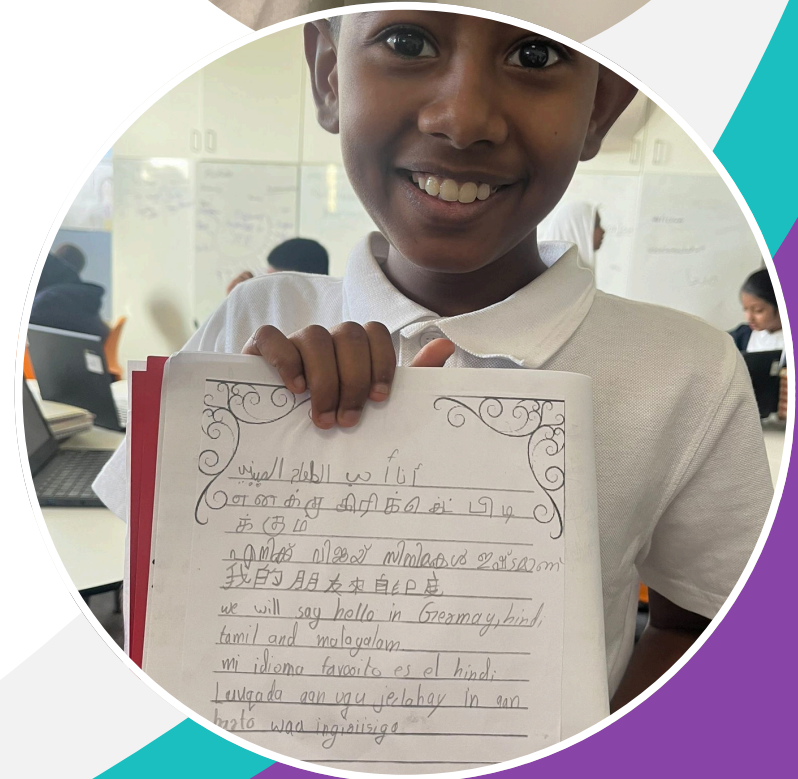
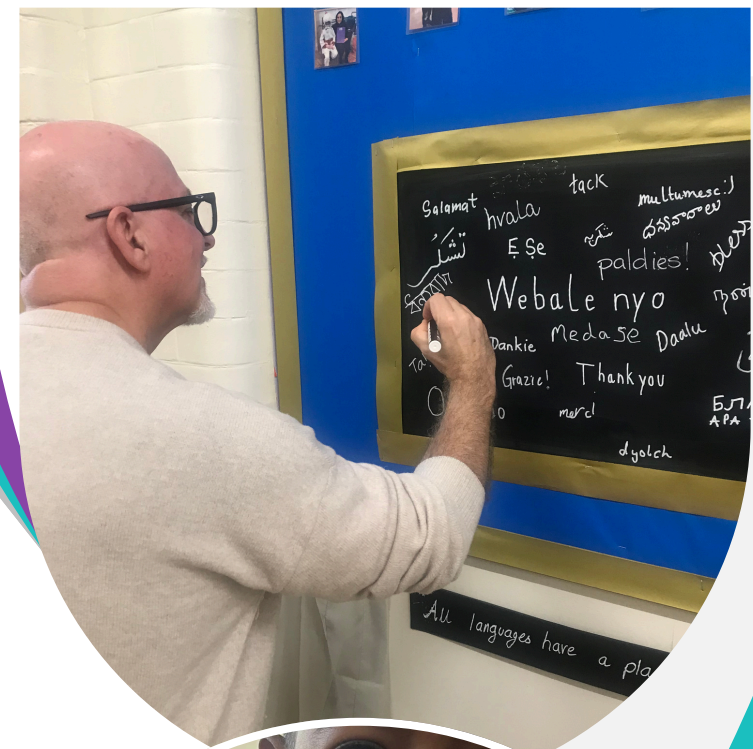

Training Breakdown

Tier 1	Tier 2
Purpose: A year-long, high-impact professional learning package that strengthens everyday classroom practice for multilingual learners across the whole school. This tier focuses on core systems, shared language, and practical strategies that all staff can apply immediately. Designed for schools that want to move from <i>good intentions</i> to <i>consistent, equitable practice</i> for multilingual learners.	Purpose: Targeted, specialist professional learning for schools ready to move beyond universal practice and refine identification, intervention, and integration for specific cohorts of multilingual learners. This tier supports key staff and teams (EYFS, SEND, pastoral, senior leaders) to make accurate judgements, provide nuanced support, and respond confidently to inspection, safeguarding, and inclusion challenges.
1. From Arrival to Belonging: Building Inclusive Systems The Arrival to Belonging Journey A practical workshop exploring the five stages of multilingual pupil inclusion: Arrival → Access → Participation → Contribution → Belonging Leaders and staff reflect on where pupils currently sit and identify actions to move them forward. 2. Leadership & Whole-School Culture

Leading on Multilingualism

Strategic guidance for senior and middle leaders on embedding multilingualism into vision, policy, and practice—moving beyond “EAL as a bolt-on” to a whole-school Multilingual Approach.

Data Democracy

Rethinking assessment systems to move beyond “best fit” judgements.

This session supports leaders to track progress more equitably and make multilingual learners visible in school data.

2. Wellbeing, Safeguarding & Belonging

Trauma-Informed Practice for Refugees and Asylum-Seeking Children

Specialist guidance on supporting wellbeing, emotional regulation, and engagement—grounded in an understanding of displacement, loss, and interrupted schooling.

Culturally Responsive Pastoral Care

Explores how culture, migration, and language shape behaviour, attendance, and family engagement—supporting more effective and empathetic pastoral responses.

3. High-Quality Classroom Practice

Adaptive Teaching for Multilingual Learners

Practical strategies to scaffold *up to* the curriculum—maintaining ambition while removing linguistic barriers, without over-simplifying content.

Questioning for Assessment & Concept Checking

How to check understanding meaningfully without relying on one-word answers.

Includes techniques such as **Cold Call**, **Wait Time**, and **Concept Checking Questions (CCQs)** designed specifically for multilingual learners.

4. Language-Rich Curriculum Access

Translanguaging: Foundations for the Classroom

Practical, manageable ways to use pupils' home languages as a cognitive and academic resource—without increasing workload or excluding monolingual staff.

Disciplinary Literacy for Multilingual Learners

Strategies for unlocking the subject-specific language of **Science, Maths, and Humanities**, supporting pupils to access concepts, not just keywords.

4. Strategic Community Engagement

Culturally sensitive approaches to engaging with multilingual families, including:

- Building trust with newly arrived families
- Reducing communication barriers
- Supporting parental confidence and participation
- Aligning family engagement with safeguarding, attendance, and wellbeing priorities

Moves schools from transactional communication to genuine partnership.
